### The Sevier Orogen: Hinterland to Foreland Evolution of a Classic Fold and Thrust Belt

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The editors are seeking contributions to this volume, especially regional and topical papers dealing with any of the following themes:

- Structural architecture and variations in structural style along the Sevier thrust belt
- Hydrocarbon resources of the Sevier thrust belt
- Evolution of the Sevier metamorphic hinterland and relations to frontal thrusting
- Stratigraphy and evolution of the Sevier foreland basin
- Neoproterozoic to Paleozoic rifting history and basin architecture, and influences on subsequent evolution of the Sevier orogen
- Late Paleozoic to Early Mesozoic tectonic events and sedimentation patterns, and their relations to the evolution of the Sevier orogen
- Influence of the Ancestral Rockies events on regional stratigraphy and structure of the Sevier thrust belt and foreland
- Relations between Sevier shortening, collapse, and subsequent Neogene extension
- Reservoir analysis of Sevier thrust belt oil and gas fields
